EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

1. Purpose. To approve establishment, design, and development of the rank and insignia to be worn by Army appointments to the position of SEA to the CJCS.1

2. Discussion

- a. Section F, 2005 NDAA, established the position of SEA to the CJCS.2
- b. General Pace selected CSM William Gainey, USA, as the first SEA to the CJCS.
- c. In recognition of his position, the CJCS approved the establishment of a positional flag and recommends the approval of a unique Army rank insignia and distinctive unit insignia (DUI).
- d. Per Army Reg 70-1, paragraph 8-5 b.(1),3 the Chief of Staff of the Army can approve the adoption of Service uniform items.
- e. Enclosure to TAB displays the recommended distinctive unit insignia and rank for the position of the SEA to the CJCS when an Army E-9 encumbers it.
- f. If approved, CJCS will pin the new rank on CSM Gainey at the January Combatant Commanders Conference.

NOTE: Preliminary coordination with the Army Staff indicates that the Army nonconcurs in the rank insignia, but will support the Distinctive Unit Insignia.4

3. Recommendation. DJS sign memorandum at TAB. SJS: DJS supports establishment of the DUI. Proceed. MGen Custer





- 2. In view of the symbolism and tradition a flag holds within the military, I approve the creation of a flag for the position of CJCS Senior Enlisted Advisor.






