SUBJECT: Department of the Army Sergeant Major

PURPOSE: To reply to USARPAC recommendation to establish a Department of the Army Sergeant Major

DISCUSSION

1. In conjunction with the Sergeant Major Conference on 25 October 1965, USARPAC has recommended for the second consecutive year that the position of Sergeant Major, United States Army, be established. This recommendation has previously been referred to the Office of Personnel Operations for evaluation and recommendations. Subsequent to the 1965 Sergeant Major Conference, Office of Personnel Operations evaluation of the 1964 proposal was received recommending that such a position be established.

2. In accordance with Office of Personnel Operations recommendations, a determination is now being made of requirements for position identification. Pursuant to this determination of duties, skills and knowledges, and prerequisites, recommendations will be made to the Chief of Staff, U.S. Army, to establish in his office the position of Sergeant Major, U. S. Army.
